Alternatives to Violence Project third level workshops are an opportunity to train as a trainer. In order to empower individuals to become facilitators, leadership is learnt by leading. Completing a third level does not necessarily lead to facilitating AVPO workshops though. 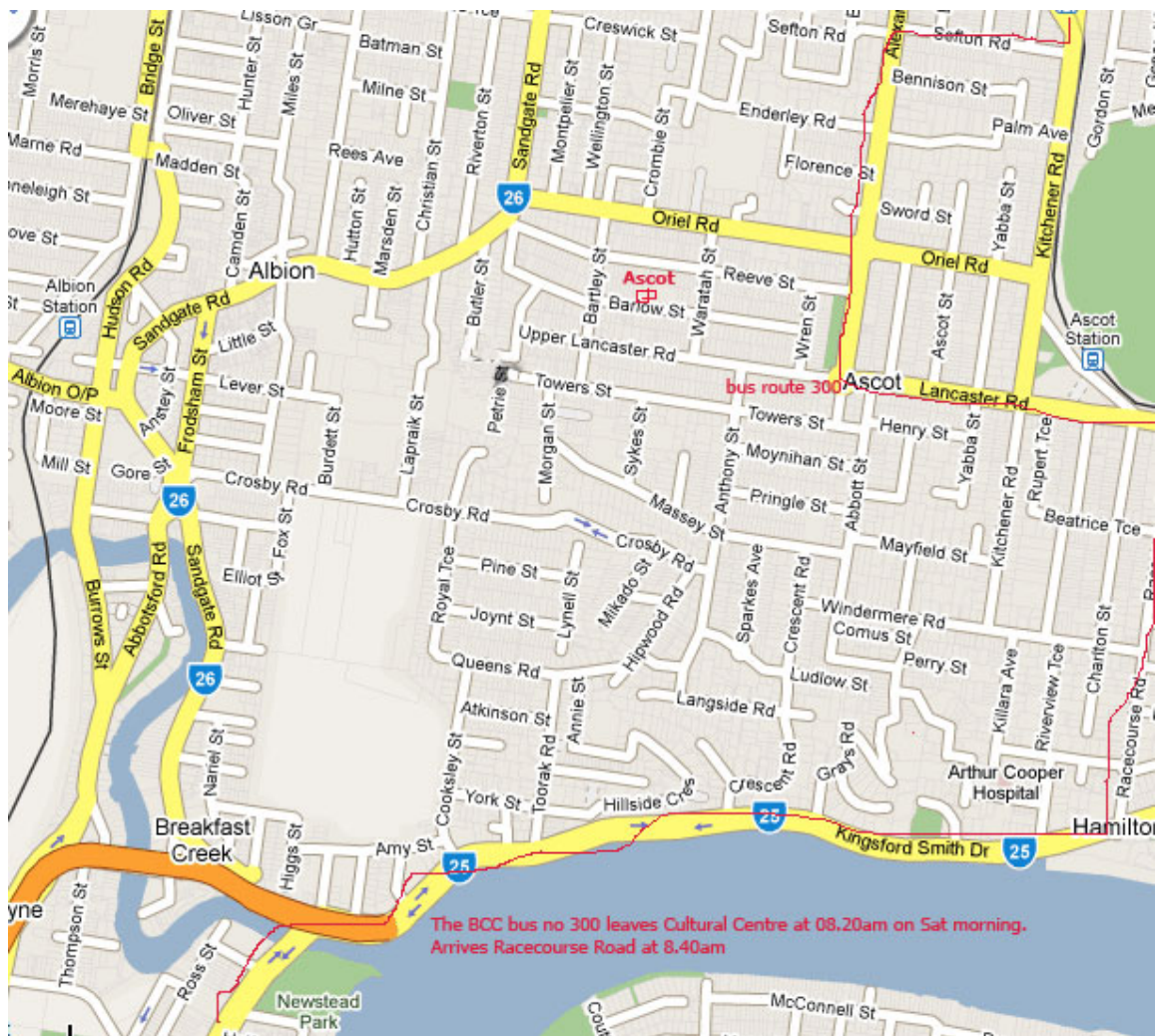

How to get to PCYC Ascot

Address: 56 Barlow St, Ascot. Cars park on the street out the front.

Bus: no. 300 stops close by (see map) and short walk. Other buses may suit your departure point.

Train: Ascot train station is a little further than the bus stop, however it's a short walk. The train operates to Ascot on Saturday but not on Sunday. In the past, people who come to the workshop by train on Saturday, have taken a train to Albion on Sunday where others from the workshop pick them up and drop them off.
